Soccer - tied result at the conclusion of full time

In the event of a tie in finals, two halves of 10 minutes is to be played (Note: the golden rule rule is NOT applicable). If still a tie after extra time then five penalty kicks will decide the winner.

Information for Yr 9 & 10 Semi-Finals & Finals

The semi-final structure involves the top 4 teams on the ladder (single fixture), or the top 2 teams from each pool (separate fixtures). In football, the winning teams from the major semi-finals (1st v 4th, 2nd v 3rd) then go through to play off in the grand final. No other teams play in the finals week. The same applies for Soccer, with the winners from Blue 1 v White 2 and White 1 v Blue 2 moving through to the grand final, no other teams play in finals week. Final rankings are based on the results of the semi finals and ladder positions as at the conclusion of the home and away season.
